- Posters on specific projects and activities

Conference language: Slovak, Czech and English. The maximum extent of the contribution and the date of submission of the complete version for review by the conference on-line system determines the category of contribution. Contributions not delivered until the deadline, will not be published in the conference proceedings. It is required the presentation of the contribution at the conference by at least one author.
